

Push the paddle under the seat in




PUSH DOWN seat to lock the frame (You will hear "Click" sound)


Please make sure nip-glide is fully open before use



Release auto lock by pushing the latch to left and hold then lift up the seat










MUST ACTIVATE BRAKE (NO "GO" MODE) for SEAT mode







NIP can take Maximum Weight 120kg/265lbs
NIP handle height can be adjustable 74-93cm/30-37"
Recommended height of user is 150~185cm/4.9~6ft
NIP Max turning distance is 85cm/33.5" diameter



Please don't use nip-glide for any other purpose such as wheelchair/stroller than as a walking aid.

Do not hang anything from nip-glide handles or frame.

Do not use the seat without the back rest in place.

Recommend to consult with your doctor, physiotherapist or OT regarding you are suitable to operate nip-glide correctly.

MAX load for TUCK(BAG) is 5kg. If it exceeds max weight, it could put you at risk when using nip-glide.



Regularly verify that screws(seat area) are properly tightened.


Make sure your brake works well. If there is any sign of brake wear, please contact the service centre. Contact us by emailing help@bc2-limited.com

Keep wheels clean and replace wheels if worn or damaged

Care Instruction for tuck(bag) and cozy(cushion)

Brush off dirt / Hand wash in warm water only / Rinse well / Do not tumble dry / Do not Iron / Do not bleach


/ Do not dry clean / Dry in shade away from direct sunlight / Do not use detergents



Recommanded TUCK(BAG) position

TUCK can be placed outward of seat when user is seated

MUST NOT EXCEED MAX WEIGHT(5kg)
